Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections for classes 1st to 10th shall be restricted to 18 only. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of 500 sq ft and greater in dimension. The school is directed to run at least 01 section each of bal vatika I,II & III in accordance with the established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24.03.2023 and 25/2023 dated 11.09.2023.
2	The composite science lab is under stocked and the lab has not been set up the board guidelines notified vide circular no. 11/2022. The chemicals and instruments are placed in open without proper locked storage area. Further, plastic chairs for seating arrangement are not recommended and safe due to heating facility and concentrated chemicals. School is directed to arrange the lab in compliance of board guidelines and upload the compliance with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
3	The math lab is also under stocked and limited instruments are placed on the tables for display. School should equip the lab with recommended infrastructure including learning

	aids, kits, measurement instruments, manipulative material etc. as notified by the board vide circular no. 11/2022 . The compliance should be uploaded with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
4	Library is under stocked and needs proper stock/books on classics, autobiographies, biographies, travelogues, essays, fiction, poetry, drama, recreational and motivational materials. Dictionaries, encyclopedias, yearbooks, children's magazines, illustrations, maps and charts . Further, separate reading area should be arranged for the teachers. The compliance should be made on SARAS portal within 03 months.
5	The school has not arranged the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls at each floor and in all the building blocks. The school campus should be CwSN friendly in compliance of the Circular no. 05/2023. Further, the available CwSN toilets are arranged in small regular cubicles having inadequate space for movement and navigation of wheelchairs. The school should upgrade the CwSN facilities and infrastructure as per notified guidelines(Circular no. 05/2023) and compliance should be uploaded with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
6	Outdoor sports facilities also should be upgraded in compliance of Board guidelines vide circular no. 11/2022. Sports specific infrastructure should be available with recommended sports facilities. Compliance be uploaded with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
7	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bhubaneswar within 3 months and submit the compliance on SARAS portal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye - Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.

9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
